

The Wetherby track provides a very fair test for any horse, but is ideal for the free-running, long-striding individual with plenty of jumping ability.



HURDLE RACES will normally be run over the New Hurdles Course, but the Stewards reserve the right to use the Old Hurdles Course if they consider it desirable.
