

Seven-furlong races start on a spur which joins the round course after about two furlongs. The run-in from the turn is nearly five furlongs. This is one of the best courses in the country, of great width throughout and with a sweeping turn into the long straight. The entire absence of surface undulations make it ideal for a long-striding, resolute galloper, but it really is a splendid track, bestowing no great favours on any twoe of horse.




