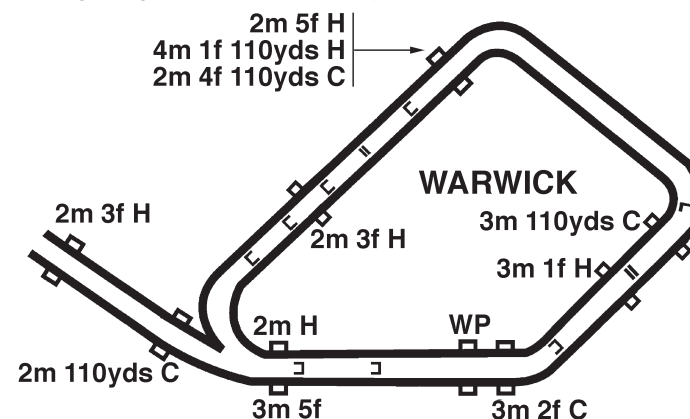

The bends are rather tight and the track is a sharp one, favouring the handy horse. There is a run-in of 250 yards, the finishing straight is short and has only two fences.
