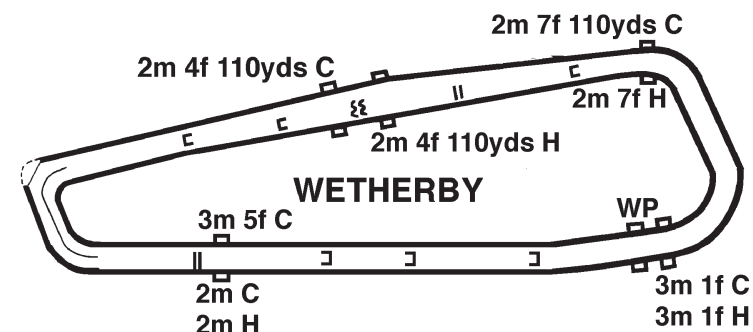

The horses are listed on the Timeform Race Card with their official race card numbers. The jockeys listed are those declared to ride at the time of going to press and are subject to amendment. The course is left-handed, with easy turns and follows a long oval circuit of a mile and a half. There are nine fences, and in races over three miles all the fences are jumped twice. The slightly uphill run-in is comparatively short for the chasers. The Wetherby track provides a very fair test for any horse, but is ideal for the free-running, long-striding individual with plenty of jumping ability.
